Deciding Where to Post

- Review grant to determine what your staffing needs are with respect to language, location, cultural groups, and practice area.
- Consider your budget for posting the position because it may cost money to post.
- Consider benefits of a local/regional vs. national search.

- National and local membership organizations (e.g. Black Lawyers Association, Lesbian and Gay Bar Association, Women's Bar Association, Hispanic National Bar Association)
- Idealist- popular job posting site for nonprofits

- State agencies (e.g. Office for Victims of Crime)
- LinkedIn (paid posting and/or having staff share the posting)
- State sexual and domestic violence coalitions
- Local law schools
